### **EVERGREEN WATERPARK GROWS CLOSER TO GRAND OPENING**



The Wings and Waves educational water park is set to open early this summer on the Evergreen campus, which already includes aviation and space museums, outdoor recreation areas and an IMAX theater. The target grand opening date is June 6, the 10th anniversary of the opening of the aviation museum. Wings and Waves will feature fun and educational exhibits focused on water, aviation and space. A children's museum and numerous interactive, educational exhibits are planned. Evergreen's next project will be a 90,000-square-foot lodge next door. Modeled after lodges built by the Works Progress Administration in the 1930s, the facility will feature conference space, a wine bar, a restaurant and a gym.
